# JUNIOR ATHLETES PLACE IN ELITE ALL-STAR BEACH VOLLEYBALL SHOWCASE

Top teams from across the US competed in the 3-day tournament, hosted by the Florida Region of USA Volleyball.

**Tavares, FL – August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2014 –** The 2014 ROX East Coast Beach All-Star Championships took place at Hickory Point Beach sand volleyball complex July 16<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup> in Tavares, FL. Forty three teams took the courts as they battled it out in their age divisions. Both girls and boys teams competed, ranging from 12 and under to 18 and under.

This event was also a college scouting combine, as college sand coaches were invited to attend from across the US. The first two days of the event, the athletes played with their partner to determine the best team on the beach. Florida teams qualified for the all-star event based on their NVL/ROX Beach Series rankings, a national grassroots beach volleyball tournament series and affiliate membership program that supports existing beach volleyball club directors, tournament directors and facility owners nationwide. This series provides a national ranking system for players competing in these sanctioned tournaments. Athletes who placed in this tournament won a bid to the NVL/ROX Jr. Beach Global Challenge, which took place August  $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$  in Port St. Lucie, FL.

"We were honored to host the 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual ROX East Coast Beach All-Star event at our new Hickory Point Beach sand volleyball complex," said Steve Bishop, Executive Director and President of the Florida Region of USA Volleyball. "The level of talent at the event was very impressive as some of the top junior beach teams from across the US took to the sand for bragging rights. This year we had teams attend from Florida, Texas, and California...all hotbeds for the growing sport of junior beach volleyball. After two days of intense team competition, the best athletes rose to the top on day three and took home their respective king and queen crowns in our junior king/queen competition. They were a bit tired, but seem to enjoy every minute of the competition. We expect to hear great things about the athletes that participated this year and we hope to have many of them back next year for an even bigger event."
