Our journey started back in 2012 with a women's team and a dream. A men's team was added in 2013 when the PVL was expanded to include a men's division. The Florida WAVE teams have had strong finishes each year with great support from the Florida Region members and Board of Directors. Our great partners include ASICS America, Molten USA, 1st Place Volleyball, RX Massage Therapy, and Ultra Ankle. Each year we hold tryouts and identify twenty four (24) training team athletes for each roster to compete in exhibition matches during the regular season. From the training team rosters, the coaches select the top twelve (12) athletes for the travel team rosters. This has truly been a team effort over the first five years and we are excited about the future of the Florida WAVE and the PVL. Go WAVE!"
