HICKORY POINT BEACH IN TAVARES, FL TO HOST COLLEGIATE BEACH VOLLEYBALL EVENT, FEATURING TEAMS FROM ACROSS THE US

The Stetson Beach Invitational will be held March 17th – 18th, 2017 at Florida's largest single-site beach volleyball complex, Hickory Point Beach. This event is free and open to the public.

Tavares, FL – March 6th, 2017 – The Florida Region of USA Volleyball is excited to host the 2017 Stetson Beach Invitational at their 21-court beach volleyball complex, Hickory Point Beach, located in Tavares, FL. This event will feature seven (7) NCAA Division I & II beach volleyball teams from across the United States. The schools include Stetson University (Deland, FL), Georgia State University (Atlanta, GA), Jacksonville State University (Jacksonville AL), University of New Mexico (Albuquerque, NM), Florida Atlantic University (Boca Raton, FL), Morehead State University (Morehead, KY) and Lincoln Memorial University (Harrogate, TN.)

The Stetson Beach Invitational has historically been held on the Stetson University campus. This will be the first year that it takes place at Hickory Point Beach. **Kristina Hernandez**, Stetson Volleyball Head Coach, said, "We are so excited to be partnering with the Florida Region and Hickory Point Beach to host our annual Stetson Invitational Tournament. The facility has a great layout, sits on a beautiful lake and allows us the ability to run duals on 5-6 courts to get more great competition in. We are looking forward to a great competitive event with teams from all across the country and hope to continue our relationship with the Florida Region and Hickory Point Beach for future events."

Hickory Point Beach was completed early July 2014. The Florida Region partnered with Lake County, Florida and Lake County Water Authority to jointly build the project on the 68-acre Hickory Point Recreational Complex, next to Lake Harris. This state-of-the art facility offers professional level net systems, stadium quality lighting, a professional speaker/intercom system, antennas & pads on every court, short court lines, 24 inches of top quality washed white sand, 20 feet minimum between courts (side-to-side) and 35 feet minimum between courts (end-to-end.)

Additional amenities available at the complex include free parking onsite, permanent restrooms, beautiful views of Lake Harris, a children's playground, outdoor showers near courts, a nature trail, a swimming area, BBQ grills with picnic table, a free boat ramp with dock access and much more.
