# **TEAM FLORIDA DOMINATES; BRINGS HOME 3 GOLD MEDALS**

3 out of 5 Team Florida High Performance volleyball teams earned gold medals at the 2018 USAV HP Championships in Tulsa, OK.

**Eustis, FL** –**August 1, 2018** – Every year since 2000, The USA Volleyball High Performance Championships have been held to showcase the best junior athletes from across the globe. They come together to compete against one another in a weeklong tournament. Five teams represented Team Florida this year, four girls' teams and one boy's team. The event was held in Tulsa, OK at the Cox Business Center from July  $24^{\text{th}} - 28^{\text{th}}$ .

The Florida Region is proud to announce that three of their five teams won gold medals. The three gold medals went to Boys' National Youth (ages 16-17), Girls' International Youth (ages 15-16) and Girls' National Select (ages 14 and under). Team Florida earned 6<sup>th</sup> place in the Women's International Juniors division and 8<sup>th</sup> place in the Girls' National Youth division.

This is the fifth consecutive year that Head Coach **Flavia Siqueira** led Team Florida to a first place finish in the Girls' National Select division. The Girls' National Select team had a tougher road to the championship match this year since they lost a match on the first day of the tournament. This was the first time the Girls' National Select team had lost a match since the 2012 USA Volleyball High Performance Championships. Coach Siqueira stated, "I believe that losing that match was the best thing that could have happened to our team. After the loss, we had a team meeting and players not only talked about volleyball but also about using that moment to grow as young ladies. That meeting made them trust each other and our team chemistry changed completely." In the championship match, the Girls' National Select team beat Aloha Girls' National Select (23-25, 20-25, 25-18, 25-10, 15-10). When asked about the moment her team won gold, Coach Siqueria said, "The feeling of winning is always amazing! Coach Gio and I looked at each other and just smiled! Then Coach Danny joined us in a group hug and we could only smile... it was pure joy."

This is the second year in a row that Team Florida won gold in the Girls' International Youth division. Team Florida's Girls' International Youth team went 8-0 throughout the entire tournament and only dropped 2 sets over the whole 5 days. Athletes **Alanys Viera** (setter), **Jangelyz Ramirez** (libero) and **Kallista Cors** (outside hitter) were named to the All-Tournament team. In addition, Cors was named the MVP of the Girls' International Youth division. "I'm speechless," Cors said. "This is my first year doing HP and this is one of the greatest experiences ever. I loved it so much. I love all the girls; the coaches are awesome. This tournament was the best part of my summer."

This is the first time in program history that Team Florida's Boys' National Youth team has earned a gold medal. Head Coach **Tom Snodgrass** said that, "The mindset of our team and coaching staff was to improve our chemistry every time we stepped foot on the court. Once we accomplished that, nothing was going to stop us!" Team Florida beat Southern California Volleyball Association (SCVA) in the championship match (22-25, 25-17, 25-10, 15-25, 15-11). Outside Hitter, **Omar Hoyos**, commented, "In the beginning of the tournament we were still getting use to each other, the sets and communicating. You can see in the game that we weren't talking that much but by the third day we peaked and starting getting closer to each other, communicating better and in the finals that's what we did and that's why we won."

High Performance has made a positive impact on the Florida Region by bringing all-star athletes, college coaches and club volleyball coaches together from all areas of the state. Team Florida was sponsored and outfitted by ASICS and Baker's Sporting Goods.

"What a great group of athletes and coaches" commented **Steve Bishop**, Executive Director/President of the Florida Region. "This year, like many before, our delegation was focused on performing at their highest level and making it to the podium. Having 3 of our 5 teams win gold was an extraordinary performance and allowed our delegation to be the highest finishing region for the 5th year in a row. There is something magical that happens when everything comes together and teams hit the highest tier of the team-building pyramid. They achieved a level of volleyball nirvana that is hard to describe. I enjoy watching it happen every year and I salute the parents, athletes, coaches, staff, and sponsors for supporting our program the way they do year after year. Go Team Florida!"
